

## **NO CAMPFIRE ZONE DEFINITIONS**

### **Escalante, Paria and Hackberry Canyons**

The no campfire zone includes all canyons within portions of the Escalante and Paria/Hackberry Watersheds located inside the Monument (Map 4). A canyon is defined as extending from rim to rim (top of the cliffs defining the canyon), including the canyon floor. A person has not reached the canyon rim if they can still climb higher within the canyon (Figures 1-3). Campfires then, are allowed above a canyon's rim, i.e., mesa top, though only dead and down wood can be collected. If you decide to have a campfire above a canyon's rim you are required to follow the SRP Stipulations located on pages 3 and 4 of Appendix 6 and strongly encouraged to follow both the Leave No Trace and Tread Lightly land ethics in Appendix 8.

### **No Mans Mesa**

The no campfire zone includes all of No Mans Mesa, starting at the base of its surrounding cliff (Map 5).
